Adjust your keyword search using these options:  
 Boolean/Phrase = use all operators and phrase markers.  
 Find all = automatic AND  
 Find any = automatic OR

Use the search box to search for sources that mention the keyword(s) for which you are searching.

Always make sure that you select the "Full Text" option, so that you can read the articles online.

This column has ways to sort your results.

- You can limit your hits by date
- Limit to only sources with pictures
- ALWAYS MAKE SURE THE "Full Text" BOX IS CHECKED.
- If you make changes, click "Update" for them to take effect.

Your list of hits is located in the middle column.

- Any hit marked "HTML Full Text" can be read directly from clicking the title link.
- If the article is marked "PDF Full Text", click the title link, print the citation information, and then click the PDF link from the citation information.

Use this link to see what related topics are available.

Click the title to access the text.

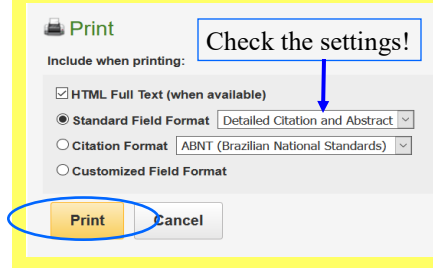
Use the summary (abstract) to evaluate the usefulness of the hit.

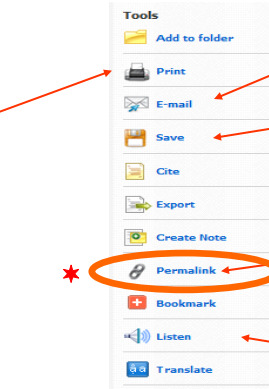
## Printing & Tools

If your article is available as HTML Full Text, the detail record information and the article will print using the Print tool—just check that the setting is still set to: Detailed Citation and Abstract.

If your article is only available as a PDF Full Text, print the detail record information **BEFORE** you print the pdf. To print the pdf, use the pdf tool bar from the top of the article.

Use these links to navigate when using *MasterFile Premier*. Try NOT to use the “Back” button—you can lose your search.
