Citing Salem Online

In *Salem Online*, citation information comes from **3** places:

- 1. The end of the article. Use information from the sample MLA citation to complete your citation guide.
- 2. Use the information about the computer program (Publisher and date) that is listed at the bottom of the web page when open on the screen.
- 3. The URL is located in the browser's address bar. Make sure to copy and paste the complete address. DO NOT USE THE URL FROM THE SAMPLE CITATION!
- Below is a sample breakdown of a Salem citation.
- Use it as a guide to complete your MLA Citation Guide.
- There may be other information for your source, such as volume information, so be sure to watch for extra information and record it in the correct place on your guide.
