MLA Hints:

*Since the information from the Occupational Outlook Handbook was written for the site, it only has information for Container 1 (original)— Leave Container 2 (copy) blank.

*Remember to correctly format information based on the citation guide directions, NOT what is shown on the site.

MLA Breakdown:
