  - Your four required sources of information must be:**
    - ◆ 4 literary criticism articles:
      - Literary Reference Center,*
      - Bloom's Literature,* and
      - Literature Resource Center*
    - ◆ You are not permitted to use any sources other than the ones listed above.
- ✓ Your paper will focus on the thesis that your assigned author should be considered a classic author because...
- ✓ Your argument for this thesis must include (but is not limited to) ...
  1. The author's career, popularity, and/or impact on society (minimum of one in-text).
  2. The author's genre of writing and common themes that appear in the author's work (minimum of two in-text citations).
  3. Critical opinion of the author's work (minimum of two in-text citations)
- ✓ You will organize your answers into a paper introducing the author and his work to your reader.
- ✓ Do not forget to include in-text citations when appropriate and required.
- ✓ Your project must include a formal Works Consulted page to be turned in as the last page of your paper.
